

The Clinton C. Keeler Scholarship in English Studies

The Clinton C. Keeler Scholarship is awarded to a PhD candidate in English. Any graduate student who has completed at least 12 hours of graduate work above the requirements of their previous degree toward a Ph.D. in English or 12 hours of graduate work toward an interdisciplinary Ph.D. degree may apply. Applications will be processed by the Department Scholarship Committee. Selection of scholarship winners will be based on the following criteria: 1. Academic achievement as evidenced by (a) grade point average in graduate work and (b) publication and research. 2. Participation in professional activities. 3. Service to the Department (including teaching if applicable) or Community. The Committee may solicit Graduate Faculty recommendations in determining Keeler Scholars. It chooses to do so this year and asks that students please include 2-3 such letters of recommendation with their application.
